- 14. The student should print a summary of the application for his or her records.
- 15. The student will receive an acceptance email once the application has been reviewed and participation has been verified with the group or organization.
- 16. The acceptance email will contain the student ID and link to the SIG student portal that contains important information regarding the program and allows the family to fill in supplemental information (i.e. T-shirt size, allergies and dietary restrictions, roommate requests, etc.) The required medical forms should also be downloaded from the website, completed by the parent / guardian and pediatrician and returned to SIG no later than May 15, 2011.
